Appliances, Large (in working condition): 4, 10, 11	Clean appliance
Large (scrap & tagged free of oil or Freon): 1, 3, 4, 24	24 (call 742-8269 for pick-up; \$20 fee)
Small (in working condition): 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10,11	Clean appliance
Small (scrap): 1, 3, 4	4 (includes small motors & lawn equipment)
Batteries, Automobile: 1, 12	12 (2 maximum)
Rechargeable household batteries: 1, 13, 18, 26, 27	
Bicycles (repairable): 4, 14	Bikes are repaired and given to charities
(scrap): 1, 3, 4	
Books: 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11	5 (no textbooks; no magazines more than 3 months old)
Building materials, cabinets, sinks, toilets, tubs, fixtures: 4	Usable items in fair condition (also small motors & lawn equipment)
Cans (aluminum or tin/steel): 1, 3, 4	Rinse cans; recycle paper labels
Cardboard (corrugated cardboard only; no wax coating): 1	Keep cardboard dry; collapse; remove plastics and polystyrene foam
CDs, DVDs & cases; electronic remotes & controllers; wires & cables: 18, 27	18 (no CDs, DVDs or cases); 27 (recycling kiosk at front of store)
Cell phones, gaming consoles, pagers, PDAs, tablets: 1, 17, 18, 27	1 (\$5 fee per item); 27 (store credit may be available)
Clothing, linens, accessories: 1, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11	Clean items; 6 & 8 (accept rags); 1 (unusable only)
Compact fluorescent bulbs: 1, 26, 28	1 (\$0.25 fee); 28 (only if bulbs purchased there)
Computers/Electronics (in working order): 4, 6, 8, 9, 10, 11, 15, 16, 17, 18	Must be late models in working condition; 18 (Apple computers only)
(scrap) computers, stereos, TVs, VCRs: 1, 4, 6, 17, 27	1 (\$5-20 fee); 4 (TVs < 10 yrs old); 17 & 27 (\$10 fee may apply)
Eyeglasses: 19	Prescription glasses
Furniture (clean & in good condition): 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11	7 (cannot accept large items)
(no longer usable): 1	\$5 fee small items; \$15 fee large items
Glass bottles and jars (mixed colors): 1	Rinse glass; labels are ok; no lids, windows, Pyrex, glasses or dishes
Household hazardous waste (household cleaners, oil-based paints, kerosene, pharmaceuticals, pesticides, fertilizers, etc.): 1	Collected only during a special collection event day held twice a year; call 533-8484 for more information
Household items: 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11	Clean and in working condition
Ink jet & laser cartridges: 4, 17, 27	
Metal (scrap): 1, 3, 4	3 (will pay for metal)
Motor oil: 1, 12	12 (5 gallon maximum)
Oil (vegetable) & fat: 1	
Packing peanuts, polystyrene foam blocks (Styrofoam): 1, 2, 20	Items must be clean and intact; 1 & 2 (reuse rather than recycle)
Paper (newspaper, office paper, magazines, phonebooks, bags, paperboard (i.e. cereal boxes)): 1	Keep paper dry; glossy ads, colored paper and staples are okay
Plastic containers (bottles, jars, tubs, and similar marked #1-#7): 1	#1 - #7 on bottom of container; rinse; collapse if possible; lids & caps are okay
Plastic grocery bags: 21, 22, 23, 26	May mix with other clean, plastic bags & films; remove receipts
Shoes, purses, belts: 25	Will repair or recycle
Tires: 1	Will accept 4 per day; up to 17.5"
Yard waste (in bags or bundles 4' length, 18" diameter max.): 1, 24	1 (one load/day; ID required); 24 (loosely secure bags at top; tie bundles)

Reduce, Reuse and Recycle in Stillwater

Recycling facts:

- The average American creates about 4.6 pounds of garbage each day or over 3 tons annually per family of four
- One ton of recycled paper saves 3,700 lbs of lumber and 24,000 gallons of water
- Recycling a soda can saves 96% of the energy used to make a can from ore
- Recycling employs 1.1 million people nationwide

How to reduce:

- Purchase items in bulk
- Avoid over-packaged products
- Choose durable goods over disposables
- Buy only what you need

Reuse & recycling tips:

- Save time and energy by visiting drop-off sites on your way to other destinations
- Maintain and repair items
- Compost yard waste and food scraps
- Use a self-mulching mower and leave grass clippings on the lawn
- Make double-sided copies when printing
- Drink water from a reusable bottle
- Buy items with recycled content and “close the loop” by creating a market for recycled products

If in doubt, throw it out!

Non-recyclable items mixed in with similar materials that are recyclable may contaminate a load of material and make it unacceptable for processing. (If so, the entire load may be dumped in the landfill.) If in doubt, throw it out!

Citywide Curbside Recycling:

Stillwater households may now recycle paper products, cans, and plastic containers #1-7 at the curb in a “single-stream” polycart. Glass bottles/jars and other items will continue to be accepted at the Convenience Collection Center.

Full-service recycling drop-off site:

The Stillwater Convenience Collection Center is open Tue-Fri 10am-6pm & Sat. 8am-4pm. Call 533-8458 for information. Location: 807 S. Perkins Road (at 8th Avenue)
